All people who follow Jesus are in God's family, and he gets really excited about spending time with his family. Also, God LOVES to give us gifts, and Jesus was the best gift he could think of. Jesus came to be the rescuer, to forgive us for all the wrong choices that we make. He wanted to show us how much God loves us, and teach us how to trust him.

Verse: *Give thanks to God for this gift that is too wonderful for words!* **2 Corinthians 9:15**

Jesus is the best gift we've ever received. He's so wonderful, that there simply aren't enough words to describe it! His birth was the most unexpected way a king could come into the world, but it was exactly as God planned it.

Discuss: ● Why did God send Jesus to earth? ● What different kinds of people got to hear about Jesus' birth? How did they show their excitement? ● What were some of the things that made Jesus' birth a little unexpected? ● Why was Jesus was born as a baby outside, instead of like a king?

Do: Draw or use crafts and create a nativity scene. Here's some things to include: Mary, Joseph, Jesus, three wise men, shepherds, angels, donkeys, cows, sheep, a manger, hay, stars, etc.

Pray: Jesus, we worship you as our rescuer. Thank you for coming to the world and saving us. Help us to be closer to you, and worship you always. Amen!
