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## **Kids Can Be Leaders**

**Memory Verse:** 1 Timothy 4:12 *“Don’t let anyone make fun of you, just because you are young. Set an example for other followers by what you say and do, as well as by your love, faith, and purity.”*

Sometimes, we feel like we have to “grow up” and become an adult before you can really make a difference, but that’s not true! The Bible is full of young people who made a huge difference in the world. Today we’re talking about a boy named Timothy. Timothy was pretty young, just like you. Timothy was really excited about Jesus. He wanted to be Jesus’ friend, and be close to him. And even though he was young, he wanted to tell others about how to follow Jesus, and he didn’t let his age get in the way of that.
